

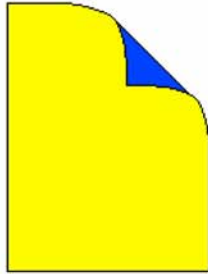
Directions for Making an Origami Frog

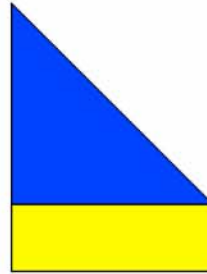
Use a business card or a 3.5 inch by 2 inch piece of card stock.

Fold the top right corner of the card to the side and make a crease, then unfold.

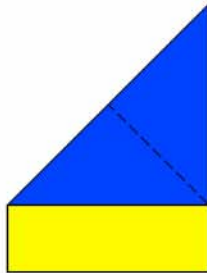

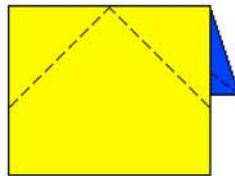


Fold the top left corner of the card to the side and make a crease, then unfold.

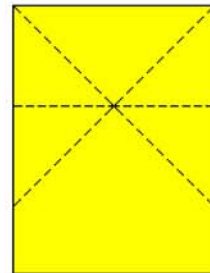

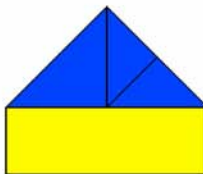
Bring the top of the card down while pushing in from both sides to form a triangle.

Fold the corners of the triangle up and to the center of the top to form the front frog legs.

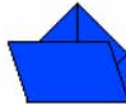
Fold the right and left sides of the card in to the center.

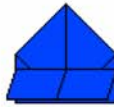
With the front frog legs up, fold the bottom of the card up to the top of the frog nose but do not crease.

10.



Fold the bottom of the card back one half the length of the last fold, do not crease. This forms the back legs of the frog.

Set the frog on a flat surface and gently flip the frog by pushing down and releasing the back portion of the back legs to make the frog hop.
