DIRECTIONS

- Drive I-75 to I-24 from Atlanta or Knoxville, I-24 from Nashville or I-59 from Birmingham.
- Take I-24 to downtown Chattanooga to Exit 178/US Highway 27 North to Exit 1-C/4th Street.
- Take a right onto 4th Street.
- Turn left at the second stoplight onto Broad Street.
- Go two blocks and see Aquarium.
- Parking and free shuttle are available.

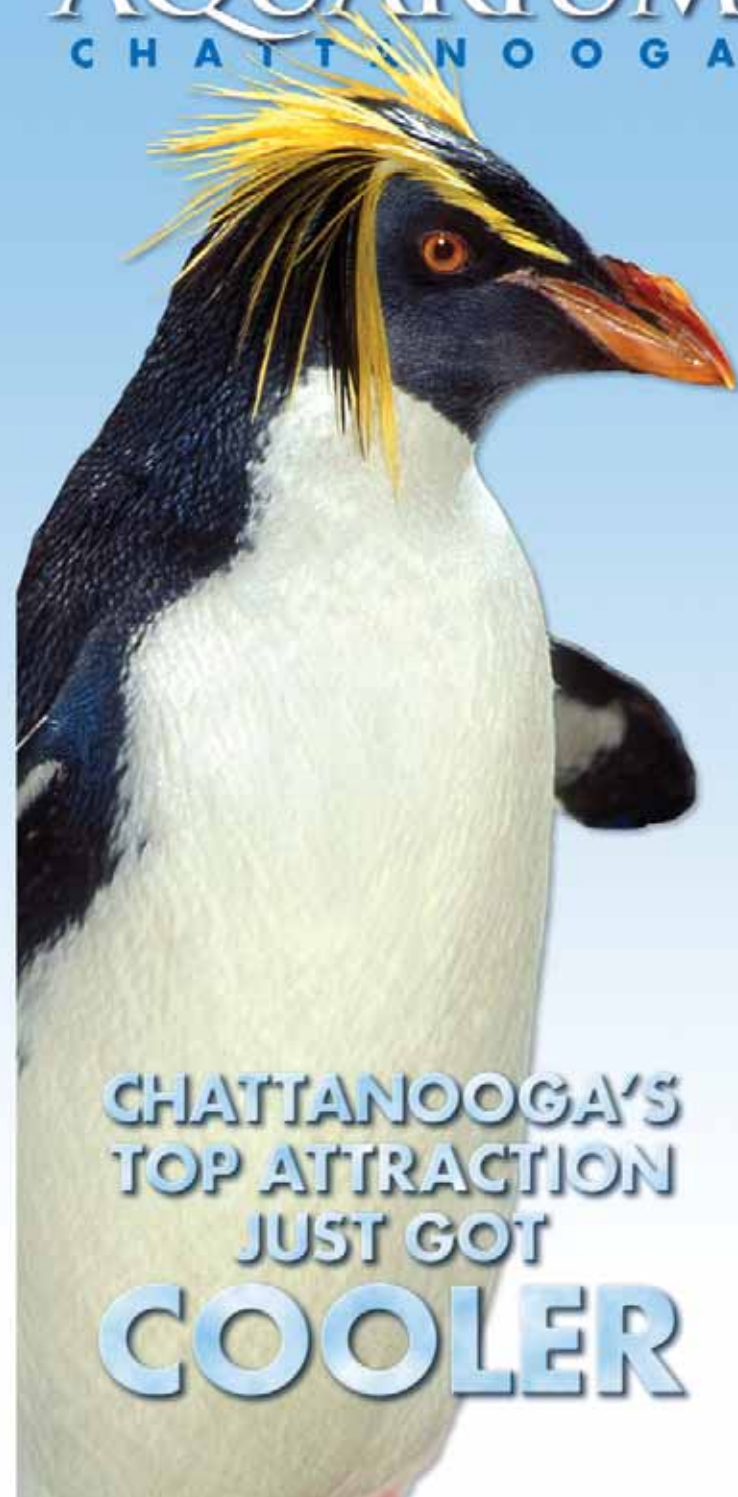
